

Information for Dual Credit for students 2016-2017:

Dual Credit Courses offered through Kilgore College

Juniors – HIST 1301, HIST 1302, MUSIC 1306, GOVT 2305, SPEECH 1315

Seniors – ENGL 1301, 1302, GOVT 2306, PSYCH 2301

Dual Credit Courses offered through Letourneau University

9th – 12th Grade – HLSC 2921

9th – 12th Grade – HLSC 2033

Information for TSI Exemption:

Eligibility requirements for academic courses and workforce education courses not included in a level 1 certificate program (corrosion technology, criminal justice, and process technology):

ACT: composite score of 23 with 19 on English and/or math

SAT: composite score of 1070 (critical reading + math) with 500 on critical reading and/or math

*STAAR End-of-Course (EOC) for 11th grade eligibility: a. English II EOC - 4000 b. Algebra I EOC - 4000 with passing grade in Algebra II May only be used for initial enrollment in 11th grade. Students who enroll in 11th grade using these scores may continue enrollment until high school graduation. Further testing may be required upon high school graduation to meet the requirements of the Texas Success Initiative, unless student has otherwise satisfied TSI through completion of coursework or other testing.

Those initially enrolling in 12th grade cannot use these scores and must satisfy TSI through one of the other assessment methods listed above.

TSI scores required to enroll in Dual Credit courses and/or to enroll as a college freshman without having to take any remedial courses or take a dual credit course:

TSI Assessment standards: Reading, 351; Writing, 350 with 5 on essay or 4 on essay with score of 363, or an ABE Diagnostic level of at least a 4, and an essay score of at least a 5; Math: 350
